As a budding Flutter Developer I assisted in migrating the company's native mobile apps to Flutter. Our team was joined by experts from Very Good Ventures for about six months, during which time I learned Flutter Bloc and the repository pattern.

Focuses were on:

- Feature migration,
- unit and widget testing,
- small PRs, and
- team collaboration (everyone had equal input with a 'no such thing as a stupid question' mentality).

We provided Flutter-based solutions by creating widgets, blocs, and API providers within a feature-based, n-tiered system.

- Added features and fixed bugs using an agile flow.
- Created Jira tickets, Stash branches, PRs, and participated in ticket analysis and code reviews.
- Added unit and widget tests: The app was kept at >80% code coverage.
- Created a custom dialog pattern that allowed for consistent customization of over two dozen Flutter dialogs.
- We worked tightly with QE (QA), and wrote test cases to cover each feature or behavior that was worked on.
- In the final months, we all began learning to apply OO design patterns and code optimization techniques.
- I also helped with a few Android styling bug tickets, and sat through a refactoring walk-through from a senior developer who detailed how a Flutter platform view communicated with Swift.

With a career adjustment in progress, I wholly focused on learning mobile app development via Flutter, Dart, OOP, and the reactive paradigm. I received a Flutter certification in Mar 2020, and began on an auth-based system for a mobile app suite.
